

Walk to Easter 2018



For many years, St. David's has opened its doors -- and its heart -- on Good Friday, to the surrounding community of children, ages 3y-9y offering a "Walk to Easter Program." The building is filled from one end to the other with excited children, parents, friends, grandchildren, grandparents, visitors, parishioners -- and God's love.



Children fill the classrooms and the Great Hall, participating in activities that reinforce the themes of Easter, not just eggs and bunnies! Sheep tell the story of Jesus the Good Shepherd. Butterflies symbolize Jesus' resurrection from death to life. Decorated egg-shaped cookies symbolize new life. Fresh made pretzels continue the monastic tradition of baking bread in the shape of praying hands. Easter cards and Easter crosses are beautiful reminders of the Easter story that can be enjoyed at home throughout the year.

Children sing, giggle, eat, and they walk throughout the church building -- listening and participating in the events of Holy Week. **They live Holy Week.** They sing and wave palm branches to welcome Jesus. They see Jesus wash the feet of his disciples at the Last Supper. They follow him into the garden and sadly stand at the foot of the cross, then bravely enter the dark tomb. **The passion of Christ is now theirs!**
